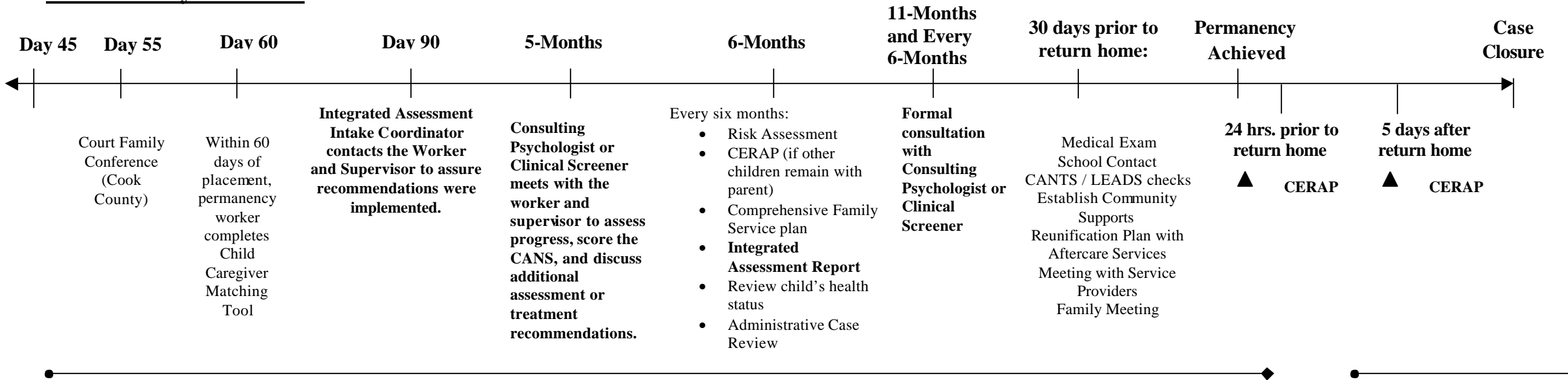


Integrated Assessment Timeline

Day Forty-Five – Case Closure

Case Activity Timeline:



- Maintain current immunizations for each child
- On-going, age-appropriate well-child exams, annual dental exams & vision/hearing screenings
- Medical referral follow-up as needed
- Acute care visits for medical care as needed
- Continued parent-child visits (at least weekly depending on goal)
- Monthly observation of parent-child visits
- Continued sibling visits (at least twice per month)
- Monthly supervision
- Quarterly Family Meetings
- Monthly in-person with child in placement (*More frequently for special needs child)
- Monthly in-person contact with substitute caregiver
- Monthly in-person contact with parent
- Monthly contact with service providers
- Twice annual in-person contact with teacher(s)
- Obtain report cards at grading periods
- Quarterly service provider reports
- Court Hearings

- In-person contact by worker within 24-72 hrs. after return home, followed by weekly in-person for first month after return home (*minimum 2 unannounced)
- Twice monthly in-person after first 30 days
- Monthly with teacher during first quarter after return; quarterly thereafter until case closure
- Medical Exam within 30 days after return

Multiple Placement Trigger Cases

The regional Intake Coordinator will be notified of multiple placement cases and coordinate an Initial Staffing to occur with 10 business days. The Worker, Supervisor, and IA Clinical Screener will conduct the staffing and develop an Action Plan resulting in a Follow-up Staffing or recommendations necessary to providing stable and appropriate placement. Other high-risk populations (triggers) will become part of this staffing process as the IA program continues to expand in the future.
