


The parties and their respective representatives must be prepared to proceed at the hearing. The parties must present all information, documents, records or witnesses necessary to substantiate their position(s) at the hearing.

Pursuant to 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.640, the Administrative Law Judge shall render a decision and issue an order on the objections pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/4 and 9, 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.100 – 120.670. The decision will be the decision for and of the Director of Labor. A certified copy of the final administrative decision shall be filed with the Secretary of State, and a copy served personal service or certified/registered mail on all parties to the proceeding.

The proceedings under this hearing are subject to judicial review in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 - 3-113. The Director of Labor's determination on the objections is final and binding unless a party to this proceeding applies for and obtains judicial review of the final administrative decision in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101-113.

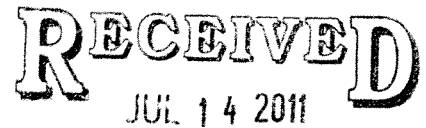
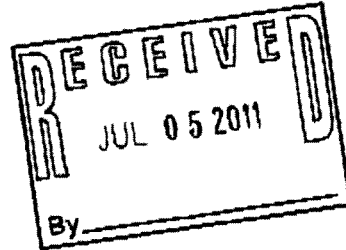
Dear Mr. Costigan:

Our firm represents Olsson Roofing Company, Inc. and William G. Lynch in his official capacity (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Olsson Roofing"). In accordance with Section 9 of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, this letter serves as Olsson Roofing's written objection and request for hearing as to the Department's June 2011 and July 2011 prevailing wage schedules for the classification of "Roofer" for the following counties: Jo Daviess; Stephenson; Winnebago; Boone; McHenry; Lake; Carroll; Ogle; DeKalb; Kane; Cook; Lee; DuPage; Kendall; Will; and Kankakee.

Olsson Roofing's objections follow IDOL Case No.'s 2007-PW-WJ06-0833, 2007-PW-WJ06-0834, and 2007-PW-WJ06-0835, notwithstanding the fact Olsson Roofing was in full compliance with its collective bargaining agreement. The existing prevailing wage schedules do not recognize or reflect the prevailing practices and rates of roofers performing in the above-referenced counties.

Olsson Roofing submits objections specific to, but not limited to, the prevailing rates (including fringe benefit rates) set for Roofers with attention to overtime compensation, legal holiday rates, Saturday and Sunday rates, the rates set (or the lack of rates provided for) Apprentices, Pre-Apprentices and Post-Apprentices as established by the prevailing standards, and the failure of the prevailing rates to recognize the prevailing standard with respect to work rules contained within the prevailing collective bargaining agreement, including but not limited to travel and drive time. That is, the current prevailing wage schedules and enforcement practices for "Roofer" improperly fail to take into account and/or reflect the prevailing collective bargaining agreement for the above-referenced areas.
