

ORDER


THIS MATTER COMING on to be heard under the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01-12 and Notice of Hearing issued there under; and, pursuant to a pre-hearing conference, 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.40 (a) (1-6) all parties having been duly advised on the premises;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Any and all individuals or organizations interested in being granted party status in this hearing shall file a Petition to Intervene on or before August 26, 2011. Said petition shall be filed with the undersigned by said date and served upon all individuals listed in the attached certificate of service. Any Petitions received after that date will be dismissed as causing undue delay in the adjudication of the rights of the original parties.
2. All Petitions to Intervene shall comply with 56 Ill. Adm. Code 120.320.
