A New Law for People with Disabilities: What will it mean to you?

WHAT: The Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act explained by attorney Gerard Broeker, of the Statewide Independent Living Council. This Act broadens the definition of "disability," covering more individuals.

WHY: This law, effective January 1, 2009, will affect the rights of employees and the responsibilities of employers. Employees with disabilities, EEO/AA Officers, ADA Coordinators and Personnel Officers, should all attend to learn about this law.
